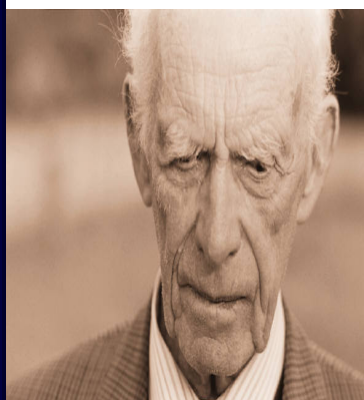


HATZILU Means Rescue

"HATZILU" is the Hebrew word for "rescue" or save. For more than 30 years, HATZILU has been maintaining the dignity of needy Jews, not only on holidays, but throughout the year. HATZILU provides the Jewish elderly and poor with food supplies, financial assistance, counseling and other basic needs. HATZILU is there with timely assistance to people caught in many kinds of hardships.

HATZILU is a network of volunteers from synagogues, Men's Clubs, Sisterhoods, Youth Groups and other service organizations.

We maintain the largest kosher food warehouse in Nassau County, and volunteers deliver food to anyone in need who requests it.



What HATZILU does: HATZILU is all volunteer! Their Executive Committee gets together once a month to go over what is being done to help existing clients and to consider new cases of families or persons in need.

Throughout the years, HATZILU has faithfully continued to provide assistance to the elderly, the poor and those who are facing a temporary financial setback or need. In recent years we have seen an increasing need by younger Jews, unfortunately, for financial help. Due to the increase of divorce, abandonment and other family situations, we find that we are now supplying emergency assistance to many younger and single-parent Jewish households in dire need.
