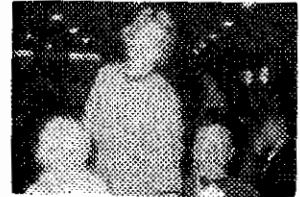
From the Desk of Robert A. Cohen President PJC Men's Club...

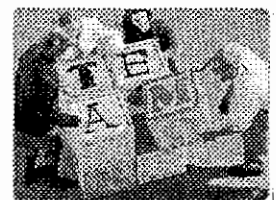

However I cannot do this without including its last paragraph which as a Brooklynite I share many of these same memorable experiences. I do this only because I have a backlog of wonderful stories that I'd like to share with you.

FINAL EPISODE OF: *MY OLD NEIGHBORHOOD in BRONX USA*

From sleeping out on the fire escape on a hot and muggy night to bathing under a Johnny Pump and washing the passing cars. From riding the rickety Third Avenue El alone at eight years old, to shopping with my mother on Arthur Avenue. From flipping baseball cards to roller skating round and round the block. Along with these and countless other memories my link to the past is strong and inviolate. For those of us who have lived in the Bronx, worked, played and grew up there, we all share a common bond, one truly unique experience. We are a breed apart. And when I say, "I am from the Bronx," I always say it with pride and a little twinkle in my eye, because those years will always come alive for me.

"NOW YOU WILL KNOW THE REST OF THE STORY" - Submitted by: Al Baker

The year was 1968, engineers at Loral Electronics Corp located in the Bronx were using some of the first sophisticated semi-conductors on some state of the art projects. Some substantial purchases were made from Fairchild Semiconductor located in Palo Alto, California. A young engineer from Loral made some frequent trips to the west coast and became friendly with the staff at Fairchild. One day this engineer received a call from one of the engineers at Fairchild. He was informed that the group working on his project were planning to leave and go into a business of their own. The call concerned a request for Loral to divide the production between Fairchild and this new fledgling company. The engineer was concerned, the very people he was depending on to supply the needed components might not be available. He went to the Director of Engineering at Loral to discuss the impending problem. The two of them decided that they would divide the order under the condition that this group would assure that Fairchild would be capable of delivering their end of the contract.

Time passed without any problem until one day a call was received once more to inform the engineer (at Loral) that this fledgling company would no longer be able to test the components – they would manufacture them but leave the testing to Loral, if not, they would have to discontinue the order. "How can you suddenly be so independent – after all we did help to start you going" the young engineer asked. The unexpected answer was, "When you see what we have, you'll understand".

If you haven't guessed yet, the startup California company was INTEL, their representative was Dr. Robert Noyce their CEO/founder and their product was the first computer in a chip (now referred to as a MicroProcessor). But that's not all. The young engineer was of all people, myself, and the Director of Engineering at Loral was another member of PJC, Chuck Benenson. Can we then assume that PJC had something to do with the Personal Computer Revolution.
