The Women's League logo emphasizes the role women play as keepers of the flames of mitzvot, family, study, Israel, Torah, and community. The **W** suggests the ancient menorah in a strong, contemporary style, and the phrase *Mah yafah yerushataynu* (How beautiful is our heritage) reflects Women's League's ongoing commitment to our vital and dynamic tradition. The flame motif also connects Women's League with the other Conservative movement organizations.
